



Hike- Triglav

Date: Friday 25–27th Sept–2009

Suggested by: Terry Howe

Description: High mountain tour to top of Triglav in Slovenia with 2 nights in a hut.

Map(s): Triglavski Narodny Park 1:50,000

Length of activity, elevation and difficulty:

3 Days. Quite strenuous with considerable ascent on 1st day To Hut(1300m), 2nd To Summit(650m), 3rd to be decided- there are 2 peaks near to the hut we could ascend before we go down to the start place.

Meeting time and place: 13:00 Friday Sept 25th. Park Place Aljazev Dom, end of unsurfaced road, 14k.south of Mostrajna, Slovenia

Ending time and place: 16:00 Sunday Sept 27th. Same place.

Public Transportation: Difficult!

Driving Instructions: Leave Vienna on the A2, past Klagenfurt to motorway intersection at Villach. South on the A11 through the Karawanken Tunnel to Slovenia(Toll). Exit the tunnel and go west towards Kranjska Gora. At Mojstrana turn South-West towards Alizadev Dom (road ceases to be surfaced after a time-care needed). Park at hut (Fee). About 5 hours.

Car sharing: Terry Howe to co-ordinate. Please indicate at registration if you need/can offer a lift.

Recommended Equipment: Lugged-sole Alpine boots, Clothing for high Alpine tour – full waterproofs, hat, gloves, sunscreen, warm layers and spare clothing. Headlamp(LED) and sheet sleeping bag.1 or 2 liters liquid plus day snacks(food is available in the hut).Emergency bivouac sack/space blanket. Club card for hut.

Comments: Ascent to the hut (Dom Valentina Stanica 2332m.) is by a very steep path protected by cables (simple Klettersteig). Participants must be experienced in this type of activity and suffer no vertigo/dizziness as absolute sure-footedness is needed. This is not a walk but a high alpine expedition.

In case of poor weather, please check with the organizer on Thursday 24th if the trip is proceeding.

Registration required: Yes, preferably by email.

Membership in Alpenverein required: OeAV membership or equivalent is required for this trip. If you are not a current member of the OeAV you can easily join online here: www.alpineclubvienna.org/membership.htm
