

Glühwein Marathon 2009

Date: Sunday, 13th December 2009

Description: We will walk up-hill (about 200m) either from Grinzing or from Wagenwiese to Cobenzl. There we will spend some time at the highest and so called “**greenest**” Advent Market of Vienna.

There you can drink Gluehwein and Punch as much as you like or let’s say as long as you can still walk on your own legs. Afterwards we will continue to the famous SISI-Chapel behind the HIMMEL in the Vienna Woods. If it is not foggy, you will be able to see the lights of the whole of Vienna during our walk.

During the trumpet-presentation in front of the SISI-Chapel, you have a second chance to drink Gluehwein and Punch as much as you can but you should be still able to walk, because we must walk back about 20 minutes to the bus 38A to the parking-place of station Cobenzl. At the **Heurigen “Reinprecht”** in Grinzing you have a third possibility to fill you up. ;-) There we will have eventually a nice **Heurigen-Dinner** and enjoy the **LAST OFFICIAL “ALPINE CLUB VIENNA” EVENING OF 2009.**

Our event will have an open end and I hope you will enjoy it as much as I have many times the years before.

Length of activity, elevation and difficulty: Not difficult. About 200m up-hill..

Meeting time and place: **02:30 pm.** At the 38a bus-stop “Grinzing” or the end station of tram 38.

Ending time and place: OPEN END! It will begin in Vienna and it will end in Vienna..

Public Transportation: To Grinzing: with Tram 38 to the end station from the City (Schottentor) or with Autobus 38A from Heiligenstadt U4 / S-Bahn station until the Grinzing stop.

Driving Instructions: Take public transportation.

Recommended Equipment: It is absolutely necessary to wear good shoes and outdoor clothes for walking and hiking in the forest. Remember it is colder after dark; dress accordingly!

Registration required: Yes- with Leila. For the Heurigen it is absolutely necessary!
