Driving Instructions: Südbahn A2 to exit WÖLLERSDORF. Follow B21 road toward Mark Piesting and then watch for a LEFT turn toward Hohewand. After Muthmannsdorf turn RIGHT thru Gaaden and Stollhof. Shortly there is a RIGHT turn onto the toll road toward the Hohewand Natur Park. Pay the toll and follow Hohe Wand Straße to the top of Hohewand and the parking lot at Kleine Kanzel. Paste the following into Google Maps search box: **Kleine Kanzel Straße 144 2724 Hohe Wand, Österreich**

The toll is €1.45 per person and per car...€7.25 for a car of 4)

Car sharing: See the sheet sent out to registered individuals.

Recommended Equipment: Lugged-sole shoes or boots, rain gear, water bottle and snacks. For those staying over on Sat. night – a **hut sleeping sack and hut clothes and shoes.**

Comments: Visitors cars are not allowed to drive from Kleine Kanzel to the Hubertushaus. It is about a 50-60 minute walk. There is an exception for special cases. Phone me.

Registration required: Yes. We want to make sure the pig is big enough to satisfy our hunger after a nice day of hiking and climbing or whatever.

Membership in Alpenverein required: OeAV membership or equivalent is required for the climbing and advanced hikes on this event. This requirement may be waived for easier hikes. If you are not a current member of the OeAV, you can easily join online here: www.alpineclubvienna.org/membership.htm
