Snowshoe Hike Tonion

Date: Saturday 18th February 2012

Organized by: Roger Starkie

Description: A snowshoe hike on the Tonion (1699m) in the Mürzsteger Alps, starting from the Niederalpl pass. Returning the same route.

Map(s): ÖK 4211 (Neuberg an der Mürz).

Length of activity, elevation and difficulty:

Total of about 15 km, 500m of ascent and descent. With good physical condition, and good snow conditions, it is not a difficult tour.

Meeting time and place: 9.30 at Niederalpl Pass, car park at the side of the road in front of the Plodererhof restaurant at the top of the pass.

Ending time and place: 17.00 at Niederalpl. We may go for dinner or a drink after the hike.

Recommended Equipment: Lugged-sole Alpine boots, snowshoes (can be hired from Sektion Austria), warm clothing, snacks and warm drinks (no huts on route!), sunglasses, sunscreen!

Comments: In case the snow conditions are not favourable (avalanche risk etc), then I may choose another location (probably closer to Vienna) and inform the participants shortly before the trip.
